*** For those of you who have never done can collection, we wanted to just give you a heads up on a smoother way of doing this project for St. Mary's students.

First, you will need to weigh the cans. Especially if you end up taking a full truck load, or sometimes a trailer works (there tends to be more cans in fences than one thinks!). Best way to do this is to go down to Kruckow and weigh your vehicle empty before you go collect the cans. Then go back to the collection spots and put all the cans in your truck or trailer. Next you will want to go back to Kruckow and weigh your load full. Then take that empty weight and full weight and the difference will be the pounds of cans you have collected. (side note: Kruckow will not charge you for scaling if you let them know it's for St. Mary's can collection).

Once you have your weight, you can then go to the recycle center to turn in the cans. The recycle center is open on Wednesdays and Saturdays. They will help you unload the cans and then give them the weight ticket you have and they will write you out a check to St. Mary's for the cans. Then you can turn that check into Patty in the office. That's it! Thank you again for your help with this fundraiser for our great school!
