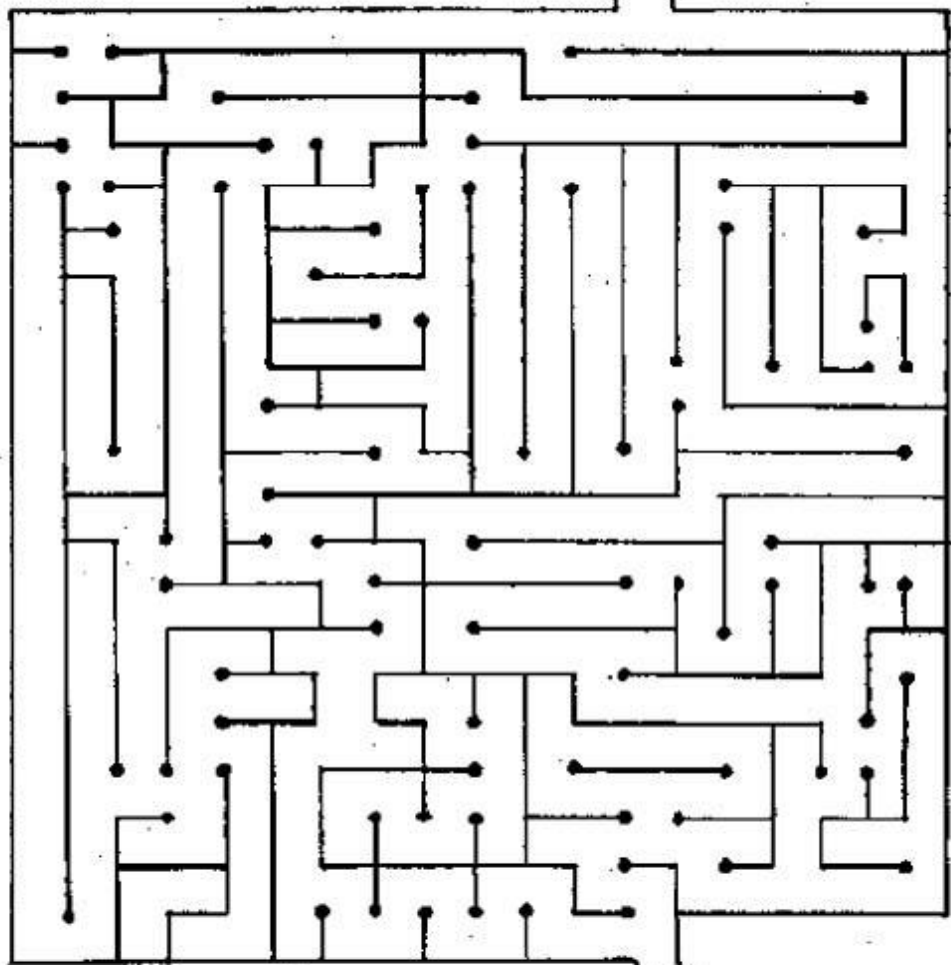
**5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Track Meet**
